

Camp Pinehurst COVID Protocols as of June 22, 2022

- 1) **ALL Non-Vaccinated Campers** (Or campers who have not tested positive for COVID in the past 90 days) need to have a negative COVID test (Rapid antigen or PCR) 2-3 days prior to arrival at camp.
- 2) **Non-Vaccinated Campers will have a Rapid Antigen Covid test upon arrival.** The results of this test usually takes about 15 minutes and the campers can wait in their air conditioned car or take a short drive around Crescent Lake to pass the time.

A **Negative** Rapid Antigen test result will allow the camper access to camp.

A **Positive** Rapid Antigen test result will require the camper to **return home and get a PCR test.** Upon a **negative PCR test result, the camper will be allowed into the camp group.**

All Campers and Staff will be given a Rapid Antigen test 3-5 days after arrival to ensure a COVID-Free Camp Bubble. We will continue to monitor for COVID-like symptoms.

- 3) **Masks: Will be available at camp.** Our mask policies are not set in stone at the moment, but all campers might be expected to wear masks at sometimes should the situation warrant it.
